## RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR THE USE OF THE SPORTS HALL AT CSE SkakAnka

- I. The sports hall is intended for individual physical activities as well as for sporting and recreational activities.
- II. The sports hall is available on a scheduled basis. Access to the sports hall and climbing area may be denied to outsiders during coached activities such as climbing, gymnastics or birthday parties. Tickets which allow unlimited daytime admission lose validity as soon as coached classes in the sports hall or on the climbing wall start.
- III. Staff members on duty at CSE SkakAnka and coaches are expected to demonstrate a duty of care towards participants and the sports hall where coached activities are conducted.
- IV. Only groups which have coached activities with an instructor or an animator or individuals who have paid a fee have the right to use the sports hall.
- V. Participants are allowed to leave the sports hall during the coached activities only with the permission of the instructor.
- VI. The amenities and gymnastics equipment in the sports hall can be used solely under the supervision of the instructor who conducts the activities. Any damage done to the amenities and gymnastics equipment should be immediately reported to the instructor or staff members on duty.
- VII. It is forbidden to drag the equipment across the floor. The sports amenities should be lifted and transported by special devices.
- VIII. The participant or their parent/legal guardian are held liable for any damage purposefully done to the sporting equipment.
- IX. Participants who wear proper athletic attire and go barefoot are allowed access to the facilities. Footwear is strictly prohibited to be worn in the sports hall.
- X. Users of the sports facilities get changed in the changing rooms leaving their garments and footwear neat. It is not allowed to get changed in the sports hall.
- XI. CSE SkakAnka will not be held accountable for any valuables left by the participants in the changing rooms. Lockers are available to rent for a fee.
- XII. Sports hall users are required:
  - 1. not to use the equipment and amenities on their own without prior permission
  - 2. to strictly follow all the instructions of the staff at CSE SkakAnka
  - 3. to keep the changing rooms and adjacent facilities clean and tidy.
- XIII. Other issues relating to the sports hall not included in the rules and guidelines are the responsibility of the managing party of CSE SkakAnka.
